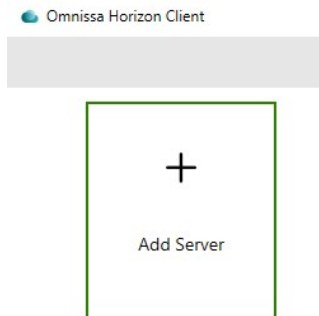


Access a Virtual Machine using Omnissa Horizon Client


Your virtual machine can be accessed through a browser or by installing the desktop version of Omnissa Horizon Client.

To access your virtual machine, go to <https://mydesktop.uas.alaska.edu>. Install the desktop client by clicking the link to the Horizon View Client that is detected appropriate for your operating system.


1. Once the client has been installed, launch the program and add a new server.



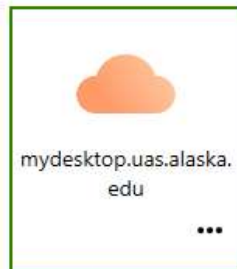
2. Enter **mydesktop.uas.alaska.edu** and click Connect.

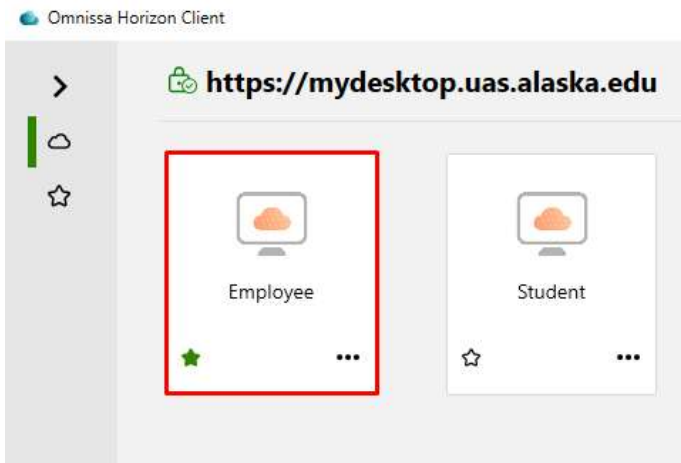
3. Log in with your UA Username/password. Set the Domain to UA.

- In the future you should see the mydesktop server populate when you launch VMware Horizon Client.



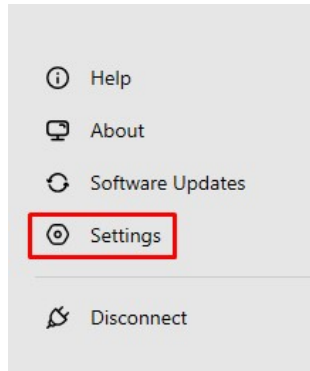
4. Double-click Employee from the list of Virtual Machines, and log in as any other UAS computer



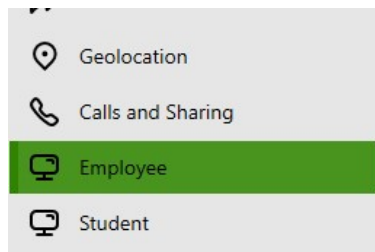
5. If this is your first time using your Virtual Machine, contact the UAS Helpdesk to proceed to the next step.

Before logging to the Employees build the first time, we recommend setting the Horizon client to Fullscreen

1. Click the Settings icon in the lower right



2. Select Employee from the left menu



3. Change the Display field to Fullscreen
