- How do you incorporate multiple perspectives and intellectual authorities in your teaching practice?
- Do you include field experiences in your classes?
- Do you use any techniques for making students feel part of the UAS community in online courses?
- Do you have any strategies for engaging students in online synchronous classes?
- Do you have any tips for building a successful online course or F2F course?
- What service do you provide to the community and how do your students benefit?
- What service do you provide to the UAS/UA/Your department/program?
- How do you celebrate diversity in your classroom?
- Would you like to expand your courses to meet the criteria for the ANKGR?
- Are your students engaged in research or creative activities with you?
- Are you collaborating in new and innovative ways with other institutions?
- What are your publications? Presentations?
