

# **NWCCU Retention, Persistence & Completion Academy**

**Project Title:** Retention through Intervention

**Project Focus:** Spring 2020 Gateway courses

#### **Project included:**

- Faculty: Early progress reports through EAB
- Faculty: Submit mid-term grades
- Staff advisors: Outreach to students
- Project Committee: Evaluation of project success

**Participants:** 39 faculty, 48 courses

**Progress Reports: 45 courses entered progress reports** 

- 29 courses had at least 1 student at risk for failing
- 15 courses had at least 25% of students at risk for failing

Mid-Term Grades: 34 courses entered mid-term grades

On average, 10% of students in each course had a D or F



Final Grades: 77% of students in the project courses passed the course

#### **Faculty Survey: 18 faculty responded**

- On a scale of 1-5, with 5 being excellent, all faculty ranked the project as a 3 or higher
  - 67% selected 4 or 5
- 94% said they would participate in the project again
- All faculty said they would utilize progress reports in the future
- Almost 80% said they would continue to provide mid-term grades
