Recent Incident Reports

In the last two months the only injury reported for the Juneau Campus was a rolled ankle. There were two incidents that related to UAS but not directly: an avalanche death of a former student in Haines; a multi vehicle accident on Loop Road near campus that involved students.

In Sitka a student had a seizure in the Testing Center. The entire incident was captured on security camera. The student recovered enough to walk out of the Testing Lab and fall down some nearby stairs. Paramedics responded and rendered aid.

Trespass
