Auke Bay property acquisition proposal to DoE

- Karen met with the Chancellor who is still advocating for UAS to maintain rights to the full facility. Allison Bidlack and Karen are developing executive level documents which will later be used in part, during a joint meeting with CBJ Assembly and Docks and Harbors (February 6). Also on that day, Allison will present to the Campus Council. It is expected that there will be a partitioning of the property and, ultimately, that may be more successful and advantageous for UAS than to try and draw up a joint-use agreement.
